Riders who wish to show and represent Seton must prove that they are show ready through sufficient & coached training for each level that they wish to show at. There are different showing levels for different experience levels of riders.

Each rider who is planning to show will also be responsible for covering all fees related to showing, including entry fees, purchasing the appropriate rider show clothing and gear (which recommendations may be provided for), and any other fees that arise. Show fees may also provide an opportunity for fundraising goals for the club as well.
